RESPONSE ETIQUETTE

- **The Automated K-HELPS System – Do We Still Use It?**

Short answer – Yes.

All of our team members are registered in K-HELPS, which is the Kentucky Health Emergency Listing of Professionals for Surge program. The Kentucky Department for Public Health (KDPH) established the (K HELPS) web-based online registration system developed to facilitate health and medical response through identification, credentialing, and deployment of Kentuckians willing to serve in emergency, as well as non-emergency situations. Everyone in the Kentucky Emergency Support Function 8 (ESF-8) is registered in K-HELPS.

When is the last time you visited K-HELPS? Please take time to go to: <https://www.kentuckyhelps.com/> and sign in. Verify your contact info is correct, check messages, and make sure you can access K-HELPS in the event of a call out for a large-scale or disaster event. We exercise this program a few times a year. It is very important that you participate in those exercises so we have a realistic view of team availability should a real world incident exist.

What about when the message is unclear on the automated call? KHELPS sends a message to your primary phone and your email. On some occasions, we will send it to your secondary phone. In addition, the message is also in your K-HELPS account in the message tab.

You can expect to get a call from KHELPS for a large exercise or a real world event!
