## RESPONSE ETIQUETTE

- WHO ARE YOU?
    - When on a response, how you introduce yourself can enhance or detract from our response efforts. It is important to lead with the discipline that best matches our consumers. For example, if we are providing services to a room of firefighters, and you are behavioral health, firefighter and minister, it is only necessary to say you are a firefighter.
    - It is NOT about us! When we give the entire catalogue of our disciplines and experiences, it becomes more about us and less about them. This is not the time to present a resume of experiences. We are there because we are a trained and credentialed team.
    - Keep the focus. It IS about the people we serve. Let's not muddy the waters or risk damaging the outcome of the response by spending too much time talking about ourselves.
