RESPONSE ETIQUETTE

- Can I give my personal contact info to people I serve on a response? No. It is important the agency or individual call KCCRB for support. If they have your number, and you are not available, it could leave them in a bad situation. In addition, it could be construed as self-promoting, and that is a violation of policy.
- Is it ok to write notes about a response for my own records? No. The services we provide are considered peer support. If notes are taken, they can be subpoenaed at a later date. Also, everything we do is confidential. If someone sees you writing notes, it breaks that confidence and looks bad for the team.
- A friend asks what kind of things we do on a response. I want to tell her about the last response I went on. Is that alright? The best answer to such a question is this: What we do is confidential so I cannot talk about the response or even where we responded. I can tell you in general what we do. We provide peer support through individual and group interventions. Remember, the integrity of the team relies on all of us maintaining confidentiality.
