THE ART OF RESPONDING

3-2-1 NO CONTACT!

When staff or coordinators contact team members to see if they are available to go on a response, it will be one of 3 ways: phone call, text message or email. When KCCRB gets a request for a response, it may be to respond that same day, or anytime within the next few days. Generally, we will use phone and text most of the time. We might use email to request availability if we have the luxury of 3-5 days to pull a team together. We usually use email to send details of location, incident and interventions to be done to those members who have committed to respond.

If you get a phone message or text or email asking if you are available to respond, please take 15 seconds, and let us know as soon as possible that you received the message and you are, are not or have to check about availability. If you know you are not available for the next few days or so, remember that we don't know that until you contact the person who contacted you.

It is not unusual that your coordinator or KCCRB staff has to contact 5-15 members in order to pull a team together. When we don't get prompt responses from those contacted, it takes more time to coordinate the response. That time can be very precious if we've been asked to deploy right away.

In order for this team to function efficiently, prompt communication is vital.
